Sudden Cardiac Arrest




Sudden Cardiac Arrest or SCA is a life-threatening emergency that occurs when the **heart suddenly stops beating.**

- > SCA is the 3rd leading cause of death in the United States; heart disease is the leading cause of death in U.S. and worldwide.
- More than 356,500 Americans die each year from SCA.
- More than 975 affected daily; presently 90% do not survive.
- > Sudden Cardiac Arrest is **NOT** a Heart Attack.



The Reality of SCA in Youth



- ➤ An estimated 23,000¹ young people under age 18 are stricken annually¹
- Many of these deaths are preventable!

Improving Survival

We can change the statistic from 10% survival to 80% survival with the tools we have NOW!

- Call-Push-Shock
- CPR/AED Training
- Accessible and maintained AEDs in public places, schools, and on playing fields
- Well written and practiced Cardiac Emergency Response Plans




2023 Legislation: Enacted & Pending


- ➤ 56 bills have been introduced in 28 states and Congress to improve SCA outcomes, including:
 - AEDs
 - CPR Training
 - CPR/AED Training
 - Cardiac Emergency Response Planning
 - Electrocardiogram Testing
 - SCA Prevention
- ➤ 11 bills have been enacted in 9 States (AL, CA, CO, HI, IN, KY, LA, TX, VA)
