We are the only advocacy organization dedicated solely to preventing opioid addiction among acute pain patients







Our mission

To prevent **opioid addiction** in the United States by increasing access to and use of **non-opioid pain management approaches**.


Cameron's Story







Problem: Long-Term Opioid Use After Surgery



Between **9.2** and **20%** of patients initiate long-term opioid use after a surgical procedure.^{1,2}

This dynamic results in millions of newly persistent opioid users following a surgery every year in the United States.

- Over 546,000 people died from opioid overdoses between 1999 and 2020.
- Over 90% of surgical patients receive an opioid prescription following surgery in 2022. 4
- Over 110,000 deaths from a drug-related overdose were reported in 2022. This is the highest number
 of overdose deaths ever reported in a 12-month period.
- Nealy 84,000 people died of an opioid-related overdose between December 2021 and December 2022-75% of all drug-related overdose deaths in 2022.
